Main Street USA

- Disneyland Railroad
 - This location is not Handicap accessible. You can board the train from any other location except for Main Street Station.
- Carnation Café
 - This location requires reservation
 - Great Baked Potato Soup and Fried Pickles
- Plaza Inn
 - Great spot to sit even if you aren't eating
 - Quick Service Seated Restaurant Location
- Jolly Holiday Bakery Café
 - Great spot to sit even if you aren't eating

Adventureland

- Enchanted Tiki Room / Tiki Juice Bar
 - You will need to get your dole whip from the outside spot as the inside line is not ADA capable
 - You can leave without watching the show
 - If watching the show, you can enter 1 of 2 ways
 - If you need your chair while in show, ask CM for assistance using the wheelchair lift
 - If you do not need your chair park it in the lobby area and return to it after the show.
 - Once the show has ended ask the CM to assist you through the front door to retrieve your assistance device
- Jungle Cruise
 - Enter from the Exit
 - Depending on the wait time they may provide you a return time
 - If you are unable to transfer from your chair your entire chair can load into the ride vehicle

- Indiana Jones Adventure
 - Go to Entrance to receive a return time
 - When your return time is valid go back to entrance to check in
 - Cast Members will direct you down the exit path
- Tarzan's Treehouse
 - This experience is not handicap accessible

New Orleans Square

- Pirates of the Caribbean
 - Go to Exit to receive a return time
 - Return to Exit to check in
 - Cast Member will direct you to the exit
 - Go to end of path past where guests are exiting the ride
- Haunted Mansion
 - This attraction is enhanced from October - January
 - Go to Entrance to receive a return time
 - If park is busy they will direct, you to an umbrella in front of the Harbor Galley
 - When you check-in they will ask if you need the walker or wheelchair with you
 - Tell them you will need the walker/Wheelchair if you are unable to stand during the wait from the elevator to the loading area (I normally can not)
 - If using an electric device they will have you transfer to a manual push chair
 - Go down side path and go through chain just before the stairs
 - A cast member will direct you from there based on what color card you have
- Café Orleans
 - Reservation Needed
 - Best meal is the Monte Cristo with the Pommes Frites
 - Large enough to split
- French Market Café
 - Good seating area if you aren't eating
 - Only location in the park that serves Mint Julep's

Critter Country

- Splash Mountain
 - Receive a return time at the Exit
 - This ride also has a Single Rider Line
 - Return to Exit to Check in
- The Many Adventures of Winnie the Pooh
 - This ride is handicap accessible
 - You will need to stand in the entire line
 - Average wait time is 20 mins

Frontierland

- Big Thunder Mountain Range
 - Go to Exit to Receive a Return Time
 - If the stand by wait time is less than 10 minutes they will let you on
 - If you receive a return time return to exit to check in

Fantasyland

- Pinocchio's Daring Journey
 - Enter through the Exit
 - No return time needed unless busy
- Snow White's Scary Adventure
 - Enter through the Exit
 - No return time needed unless busy
- Sleeping Beauty Castle Walkthrough
 - This is not handicap accessible
- King Arthur Carousel
 - If taking your assistive device on the ride with you the CM will direct, you to the loading ramp
- Casey Jr. Circus Train
 - Enter through the Exit
 - No return time needed unless busy
- Dumbo the Flying Elephant
 - Enter through the Exit
 - Depending on line may provide you with a return time
- Mr. Toad's Wild Ride
 - There are two lines at the entrance of the show building
 - The right side line is for handicap guests
 - This line is significantly shorter
- Peter Pan's Flight
 - Go to Exit to receive a return time
 - Return to exit 5 mins before return time to check-in
- Mad Tea Party
 - Enter through Exit
 - No return time needed unless busy
- Alice in Wonderland
 - Go to Exit to receive a return time
 - Return to exit to check in
- Matterhorn Bobsleds
 - This ride is mostly handicap accessible
 - Wait through line until the split point
 - Cast Member will direct you to handicap accessible entrance at this point

- Storybook Land Canal Boats
 - This ride closes during parades
 - Enter Ride through Exit
- Small World
 - Go to the entrance of the ride to receive a return time
 - Once your return time is available return to the exit to be directed by a cm down a path to load the vehicle
 - If you are unable to transfer from your chair your entire chair can load into the ride vehicle

Mickey's Toontown

*This land closes early due to the Fireworks

- Gadget's Go Coaster
 - Enter through Exit
 - Not return time needed unless busy
- Roger Rabbit's Cartoon Spin
 - This ride is fully handicap accessible
 - You can get a Fast Pass for this ride

Tomorrowland

- Finding Nemo Submarine Voyage
 - This ride is fully handicap accessible
 - There are two lines. Enter the line to the right under the Finding Nemo sign.
 - At the end of the line you will be asked if you would like to go into the Sub or enjoy the Alternate Viewing Experience
 - The Alternate Viewing Experience features a full bench and air conditioned room in the summer months
- Disneyland Monorail
 - This is a one way trip to the end of Downtown Disney District
 - You will need to wait in line at the Downtown Disney Station again to return to the park

- Space Mountain
 - During Halloween is Ghost Galaxy
 - Go to Exit to receive a return time
 - Exit contains a large air conditioned seating area next to bathrooms
 - Return to exit to check in
 - You will be asked to wait till the car is almost completely full
 - Once called you will go through the exit to the left
 - This ride features a separate load car that will be moved on to the tracks once fully loaded
 - Stay seated through the exit since the car will return to be pulled off the tracks
- Star Tours: The Adventures Continue
 - This ride is fully handicap accessible
 - You will wait through the line until just before the show building
 - At the show building entrance the Cast Member will guide you to the elevator
 - This ride does have fast pass
- Buzz Lightyear Astro Blasters
 - This ride is fully handicap accessible
 - You will wait through the entire line
 - When you are almost at the load area go straight to go through the big blue door. Do not turn to load previous to the door.
 - Once through the door the cast member will assist you.
 - The ride will be slowed down so that you can load
 - If you are unable to transfer from your chair your entire chair can load into the ride vehicle
- Redd Rocket's Pizza Port
 - The Food here is terrible ****DO NOT EAT HERE****
 - Great spot to sit even if you aren't eating

Entertainment

*Check show schedule for times

- Mickey and the Magical Lamp
 - This show has limited viewing times
 - Located in front of Toontown/Fantasyland Train stop
- Fantasmic!
 - Best if you have a Fast Pass
 - Dinning Package for preferred fast pass
 - To the right of the Petrified Tree is the handicapped entrance
- Disneyland Fireworks
 - This is only shown one time a night most nights when there are fireworks
 - Is subject to cancellation due to weather / wind
 - Best viewing spot is on Main Street in front of Candy Palace

Hollywood Land

- Animation Academy
 - This is a really nice spot to relax in air conditioning with large couches.
- Disney's Frozen Musical
 - See entertainment section of this guide.
- Guardians of the Galaxy: Mission Breakout
 - Shortest ride wait times are during a showing of Frozen
 - FastPass Available and highly suggested
- Monster, Inc. Mike & Sully to the Rescue
 - This entire ride is handicap accessible
 - If you are unable to transfer from your chair your entire chair can load into the ride vehicle

"A Bug's Land"

- Just before the entrance of this land is where you get the Fast Pass's for Radiator Springs Racers.
- All of the rides in this section are a ton of fun with or without kids
- The center features a splash pad that is really relaxing in the heat.

Cars Land

- Radiator Springs Racers
 - This ride is extremely popular and normally has a 90 minute or more Stand-by wait time
 - Make sure to get Fast Passes for this ride as soon as possible
 - The best time to ride this ride is at night. Try to snag a second set of fast passes for the evening hours
 - FastPass Available and highly suggested
- Mater's Junkyard Jamboree
 - The whole ride is handicap accessible

- This is a really fun ride if you can handle a whipping motion
- Luigi's Rollickin' Roadsters
 - The whole ride is handicap accessible
 - This is a really fun ride if you can handle a whipping motion
- Cozy Cone Motel
 - This snack spot has a really good Bacon Mac and Cheese Pretzel Cone.
- Flo's V8 Café
 - This meal location has full booths for seating.
 - This spot is also good if you need to get a bit of work done with a hot spot as it is the closest dining location to the berm of the park and gets the best cell reception.

Paradise Pier (Soon to become Pixar Pier and Paradise Park)

- California Screamin' (closing January 8th to become the incredicoaster. Check back later for any updates when the incredicoaster opens.)
 - Enter this ride through the main entrance
 - Once you get to the stairs they will direct you through a gate.
 - You will board the train from the gate entrance.
 - In order to exit go in the opposite direction of the rest of the people exiting.
 - There will be a handicap gate around the corner so that you can exit
 - FastPass Available
- Toy Story Midway Mania
 - Enter this ride through the main entrance
 - Once you get to the section where they count you in to your cars they will guide you to a side ramp area.
 - Follow it around till you find the handicap boarding / unloading area.
 - If you are unable to transfer from your chair your entire chair can load into the ride vehicle
 - FastPass Available and highly suggested

- Mickey's Fun Wheel (Closing January 8th to be rethemed)
 - This entire ride is handicap accessible
 - You can choose between swinging or nonswinging for your gondola
 - If you are unable to transfer from your chair your entire chair can load into the ride vehicle
- Silly Symphony Swings
 - Don't try going on these if larger
 - The seats are very small and don't have a very high weight capacity
- The Little Mermaid: Ariel's Undersea Adventure
 - The entire outdoor line is handicap accessible
 - Just as you enter the building a CM will pull you to the exit side of the chain and assist you with loading
 - If you are unable to transfer from your chair your entire chair can load into the ride vehicle
- Cove Bar (Closing January 8th)
 - This spot has various mixed cocktails
 - Also has its infamous Lobster Nachos
 - There is also a secret drink not on the menu called a Mickey's Fun Wheel. Definitely worth the price as it has several liquors in it and is a fruit tasting drink.

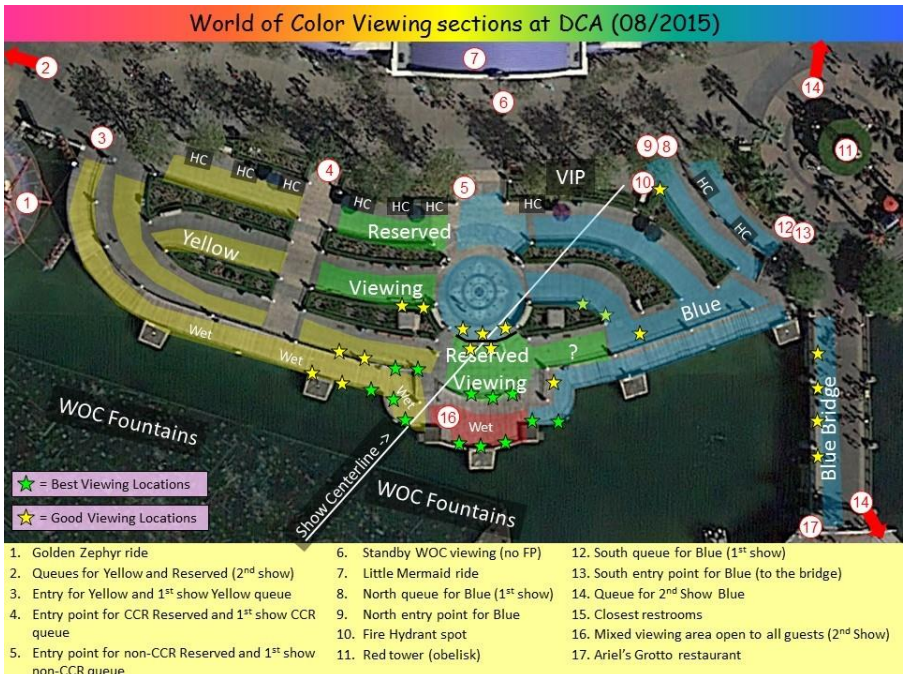
Grizzly Peak

- Grizzly River Run
 - Enter this line through the main entrance
 - Once you get at the end of the red building there will be a handicap gate.
 - Go through this gate and you will be in a separate loading area where a raft is wrangled and you are able to load without the dock moving.
 - This ride does have fast pass
- Soarin' over the World
 - This ride is fully Handicap Accessible
 - FastPass Available and highly suggested

Entertainment

*Check show schedule for times

- Disney's Frozen Musical
 - When you enter they will tell you where to go with the walker / Wheelchair
 - Go to the entrance and speak to a Cast member prior to the show starting. They will guide you to the Handicap entrance.
- Disney Junior: Live on Stage!
 - This show does have a very nicely cooled show building
 - This show building does not have traditional seating and is all on the floor sitting Indian style
- World of Color
 - Fast Passes are located next to the Ariel ride show building
 - Map has been provided below with a guide to the best viewing locations
